Letter Names: Rapid Automatic Naming

Now you quickly name these letters.



Letter Names: Say

I will point to a letter
and you tell me the name of the letter.



Letter Names: Point

I have three letters in front of me.
Point to the letter P.



Letter Names: Match

Look at these two letters.
Are they the same? (Thumbs up)
Or are they different? (Thumbs down)



PHONOLOGICAL MEMORY, MATCH, POINT, AND SAY

Rhyming: Say

Cat/hat rhyme! They sound the same at the end.
What other words rhyme with cat and hat?



Rhyming: Point

Let's look at these three pictures.
We have cat, ball, and hat. Which one rhymes, or sounds
the same at the end, as cat—ball or hat?



Rhyming: Match

Cat. Hat. Hmmmmm....do these rhyme?
Do they sound the same at the end? (Thumbs up)
Or do they sound different at the end? (Thumbs down)



Rhyming: Phonological Memory

Cat/hat, these two rhyme.
Cat/hat, these two rhyme.

They sound the same at the end.



PHONOLOGICAL MEMORY, MATCH, POINT, AND SAY

Alliteration: Say

Mikayla's name starts like moon and mall. What other words start with the same sound as moon and mall?



Alliteration: Point

Let's look at these three pictures. We have moon, mall, and pencil. Which one starts like moon—mall or pencil?



Alliteration: Match

Moon. Mall. Hmmmmmm...

Do these start with the same sound? (Thumbs up)
Or do they start with different sounds? (Thumbs down)



Alliteration: Phonological Memory

Alliteration Game, Alliteration Game.

Listen to the beginning sounds, they must start the same.

Moon, mall, Mikayla!

They all start with the same sound.
